


VALLEY VIEW AVENUE INTERCHANGE



Project Overview

The Santa Ana Freeway (Interstate 5) Valley View Avenue Interchange Project will widen I-5 to add one High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) or carpool lane, and one general purpose lane in each direction. The project extends from the Artesia Boulevard undercrossing to North Fork Coyote Creek for approximately one and a half miles through the cities of Buena Park, La Mirada, Cerritos, and Santa Fe Springs.

The improvements include widening the Valley View Avenue bridge at I-5, the North Firestone Boulevard bridge over Coyote Creek, and the I-5 freeway bridge at Coyote Creek. Additional enhancements include reconstruction of adjacent frontage roads, shoulder widening, median barriers, new on- and off-ramp designs, a railroad overpass and reconfiguring the Valley View Avenue interchange at I-5. When completed, the Valley View Avenue bridge will be widened from four to six lanes.



Project Benefits
