# 5. REQUEST FOR A TRAFFIC STUDY OF ARMSDALE AVENUE AT RICHVALE DRIVE

Senior Administrative Analyst Rounds reported the City received a request from resident Pamela Cwierz for a traffic study of Armsdale Avenue at Richvale Drive. Mr. Rounds said Ms. Cwierz requested the installation of red curb on Armsdale Drive just north and south of Richvale Drive to prevent vehicles from parking near the intersection.

Ms. Cwierz addressed the Public Safety Commission. She said vehicles park near the intersection on the west side of Armsdale Drive resulting in reduced visibility for vehicles turning north and south from Richvale Drive. She said that Armsdale Avenue is now used as a cut through for traffic from Telegraph Road and Leffingwell Road. Ms. Cwierz said that residents living in the apartment building on Leffingwell Road also park vehicles on Armsdale Avenue adding to the visibility issue. She said that one car length of red curb would be adequate to solve the visibility issue and two car lengths would be an excellent solution.

Vice Chairman Morfin moved and Commissioner Madison seconded to assign the Traffic Engineer Guilmette and Chairman Johnson to study the location and report their findings at a future meeting.

# 6. REQUEST FOR TRAFFIC SAFETY MEASURES NEAR ESCALONA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Senior Administrative Analyst Rounds introduced Assistant City Manager Anne Haraskin.

Ms. Haraksin reported that at the March 12 City Council meeting, several residents addressed the Council and presented a proposal for traffic safety measures near Escalona Elementary School. Ms. Haraksin said the proposal includes a request for additional sidewalks around Escalona Elementary School, enhancements to existing signage, the installation of a crosswalk at the school's main entrance, and the installation of speed humps on Escalona Road.

Assistant City Manager Haraksin said in an effort to effectively study the existing traffic conditions while Escalona Elementary School is in session, the City's Traffic Engineer

was already directed to conduct a study of the location to determine what measures are warranted pursuant to the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), and present the findings at a future Commission meeting.

She said a speed hump policy was last reviewed by the Public Safety Commission in 2001. Ms. Haraksin said staff is preparing a draft speed hump policy that will be presented to the Commission at a future meeting. She said the draft policy would establish a uniform practice identifying those City roadways that may benefit from the installation of speed humps and the criteria that would be used to determine whether they were warranted for installation.

The Public Safety Commission reviewed and discussed the update regarding the request for traffic safety measures near Escalona Elementary School.

## 7. 2019 ENGINEERING AND TRAFFIC SPEED ZONE SURVEY

Senior Administrative Analyst Rounds reported the Engineering and Traffic Speed Zone Study was completed. He said the purpose of this study is to establish realistic and reasonable speed zones in accordance with provisions of the California Vehicle Code, thereby meeting the requirements for speed enforcement using radar.

Mr. Rounds introduced the City's Traffic Engineer Irena Guilmette.

Traffic Engineer Guilmette completed the Engineering and Traffic Speed Zone Survey and presented a report on the study. She said a speed limit change is only recommended for Firestone Boulevard North between Phoebe Avenue and Valley View Avenue.

The Public Safety Commission reviewed the Engineering and Traffic Speed Zone Survey.

Commissioner Brasov moved and Vice Chairman Morfin seconded to recommend the City Council adopt the 2019 Engineering and Traffic Speed Zone Survey.
