The La Mirada Community Services Foundation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation for charitable and public purposes. The purpose of the Foundation is to receive contributions to support local charitable, educational and cultural purposes permitted under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

In accordance with the provisions stated in the Foundation's Bylaws, members of the Foundation may select a President and Vice President to represent the Foundation. Officers are chosen by the Board of Directors, with the consent of the La Mirada City Council. The President serves a four year terms while the Vice
