NEW BUSINESS

5. REQUEST TO REMOVE NO STOPPING SIGNAGE ON OCASO AVENUE

Assistant City Manager Anne Haraksin reported that the City received correspondence from Janice Grider who resides on Ocaso Avenue. She said that Ms. Grider requested the removal of the No Stopping signs on the west side of Ocaso Avenue adjacent to her residence.

Assistant City Manager Haraksin said that City staff and the Traffic Engineer visited the location on Ocaso Avenue. She said the width of the roadway is too narrow to accommodate two vehicles to pass each other and a parked vehicle at the same time. Ms. Haraksin said when vehicle doors are open, the roadway is further impacted, and passengers are exiting the vehicle where sprinklers and a parkway exist. She said adequate parking exists on the residential property since there are three driveways at Ms. Grider's residence. She said it was recommended the request for the removal of the No Stopping signs be denied.

Ms. Janice Grider addressed the Public Safety Commission and expressed her concerns.

Commissioner Day expressed an interest in viewing the location and requested the item be tabled. She also asked about the width of the street south of the location.

Commissioner Johnson said that not having a sidewalk in the area but allowing on street parking causes a safety issue for pedestrians accessing their vehicles.

Chairman Morfin said that the street is narrow and the width of the roadway does not allow for parking and passing cars. He said there is available driveway parking. Mr. Morfin thanked Ms. Grider for taking the time to speak with the Commission.

Traffic Engineer Guilmette responded and said that field observations indicated that the stretch of roadway had varying roadway widths between 18 feet to 40 feet. She said due to the narrow width of the roadway, there should be no parking on either side of the roadway to allow room for two vehicles to pass each other at the same time.

Commissioner Day moved and Commissioner Johnson seconded to table the item and assign the Traffic Engineer and Commissioner Day to study the location and report their findings at a future meeting.

6. REQUEST FOR A TRAFFIC STUDY OF BARNWALL STREET BETWEEN ESCALONA ROAD AND OCASO AVENUE AND AT THE INTERSECTION OF BARNWALL STREET AND LA BARCA DRIVE

Assistant City Manager Haraksin reported that the City received a letter from resident Michelle Higgins who expressed concerns with pedestrian and motorist safety on Barnwall Street near Windermere Park. Ms. Haraksin said that Ms. Higgins stated that vehicles are exceeding the speed limit on Barnwall Street between Escalona Road and

Ocaso Avenue. Assistant City Manager Haraksin said that Ms. Higgins requested the installation of crosswalks by Windermere Park and a three-way Stop sign at Barnwall Street and La Barca Drive.
