

LA MIRADA NAMED 'MOST BUSINESS-FRIENDLY CITY' FOR SECOND TIME

The Los Angeles County Economic Development Corporation (LAEDC) named the City of La Mirada as the 2019 'Most Business-Friendly City.' The LAEDC recognizes cities that create opportunities for businesses to prosper and help spur economic development in their communities.

La Mirada was selected among four cities with a population less than 50,000. The City's business-friendly climate, efficient processes, and low development costs earned the City this prestigious recognition for the second time since 2013. La Mirada's commitment to economic development is reflected through programs and services that facilitate business expansion and growth. The City keeps fees and taxes low, has never levied a utility user tax (UUT) and allowed its transactions and use tax to expire after five years, as promised.

"We are honored to receive the 'Most Business-Friendly City' award," says City Manager Jeff Boynton. "For nearly 60 years the City has remained a strong partner to businesses to enhance our strong local economy."




ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATIONS

Multi-generations of families have visited the restaurant for its delicious and authentic Mexican food. It is also a popular place to celebrate special occasions.






CASSIDY'S CORNER CAFÉ
