CITY'S STRATEGIC PLAN 2020 NEARS COMPLETION

The City of La Mirada continues to make progress towards achieving the commitments outlined in its Strategic Plan 2020. Significant progress has been made across City departments since its adoption in 2016. Over the next year, City officials will continue to allocate resources toward established priorities as the plan nears completion.

The Plan is supported by five core strategies with specific actions to monitor progress. The five core strategies include: Ensure a Well-Managed City Government, Provide a Safe Community, Promote a High Quality of Life, Provide Quality Planning and Infrastructure, and Support a Strong Local Economy.

The City continues to achieve financial stability by adopting and adhering to a balanced budget and maintaining a healthy level of reserves. The City's outstanding financial practices were recognized by the California State Auditor's office which ranked La Mirada as having the 11th lowest risk of fiscal challenge among cities in California.

Public Safety remains the City's highest priority. The City dedicates resources toward reducing crime and preserving La Mirada as a safe community. According to a recent crime analysis of 2019 statistics, La Mirada was once again able to maintain the lowest crime rate in the region. Over the last year, La Mirada's crime rate dropped by 14.2 percent.

Major infrastructure improvements continue to take place throughout La Mirada to preserve an attractive community. Recent improvements were made to traffic signals along Rosecrans Avenue and center median improvements were also completed along La Mirada Boulevard and Rosecrans Avenue.

CITY APPROVES TEMPORARY OUTDOOR DINING

The City of La Mirada has established the Emergency Temporary Outdoor Dining Program (ETODP) to provide existing dine-in restaurants with an opportunity to increase seating capacity during COVID-19 social distancing measures.

While some restaurants already provide outdoor dinging, this program allows all dine-in restaurant operators to temporarily provide supplemental seating outside their restaurants on adjacent sidewalks, walkways, and parking lot areas. The ETODP will be in effect for as long as the County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health requires implementation of social distancing and other guidelines in response to COVID-19. In order to participate in the program, existing dine-in operators must complete an ETODP registration form that can be found on the City's website. There is no fee for this program.
