
- The City will not be responsible for damage from causes beyond its reasonable control. The bench and plaque will remain the property of the City.
- If a bench is damaged or destroyed, the City will attempt to contact the donor to provide the option to purchase a new bench.
- The City will maintain the bench until the end of its useful life. Maintenance will include graffiti removal and periodic cleaning.
- The site will be maintained on a regular basis in accordance with the maintenance schedule of City park sites and facilities.
- The City will reserve the right to relocate the bench if unforeseen circumstances arise due to its location or if any future park improvement is planned.
- Once the bench inscription is submitted and approved, no further changes can be made to the inscription. No refunds are available after the bench has been ordered.

LA MIRADA Memorial Bench PROGRAM



The City of La Mirada's Memorial Bench Program provides an opportunity to pay tribute to La Mirada residents who had a positive impact on the community and have since passed away. Family and friends may purchase a bench in one of La Mirada's beautiful parks. The parks offer a scenic and peaceful setting to reminisce, reflect, and rejoice in the life of a loved one.

Once a preferred location is selected, a completed application is required to be submitted. Upon receipt of the application, the City will review the applicant's preferred park and bench location to determine if the site is appropriate and accessible.

- The cost for purchasing and installing a memorial bench as of May 1, 2021 is \$3,000. A payment must be submitted in order for the application to be processed. Checks and credit card payments will be accepted in person at La Mirada City Hall.
- Eligible parks: Creek Park, Frontier Park, Gardenhill Park, Neff Park, and Windermere Park.



- Applicants are reminded that La Mirada Regional Park is owned and maintained by Los Angeles County, and is not eligible under this program.
- The City will try to accommodate all bench requests, and reserves the right to limit locations, placement, and total number of memorial benches at any park.
