3. SENIOR COMMUNITY EVENTS UPDATE

Vice Chairperson Viayra reported on activities held at Breezewood Village. She said the Chair Yoga class was particularly popular with residents.

Chairperson Roman reported on activities held at La Mirada Landmark.

Member Thomas reported resident activities were not being offered at Somerset Glen.

Member McCollum reported resident activities were not being offered at Vista Alicante.

Member Torres said the month of May was proclaimed as Older Americans Month by the La Mirada City Council during its meeting on May 10. He reported on the Memorial Day Service at Olive Lawn Memorial Park on May 30 at 10 a.m. He said a shuttle service to Olive Lawn Memorial Park from the La Mirada Activity Center's parking lot would begin at 9 a.m. He said a celebratory lunch would be held at the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) Post 9148 following the event. Member Torres invited the Senior Council to attend the Veterans Discussion Group's meeting on June 2 at 1 p.m. with guest speaker Congresswoman Linda Sanchez. He commented on Congresswoman Sanchez's support of local veteran organizations and recent contribution of \$475,000 to the City for restoration efforts at the Neff Estate. Member Torres reported on the Neighborhood Watch program and said Members may sign up to receive the weekly crime summary through the City website.

Member Rosholt made the distinction between the Veterans Coordinating Council and the Veterans Discussion Group.
