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PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

CONDITIONAL TUP: [insert TUP title]

The City's issuance of a temporary use permit (TUP) is based, in part, on local conditions affecting public health and safety, such as the current Covid 19 pandemic, as they exist at the time of the TUP application, and as they are expected to exist at the time of the TUP event. By accepting the terms of this TUP, the applicant agrees to hold the City and its elected officials, officers, employees, and agents, free and harmless, and to release each of them, from any and all claims and liabilities arising out of the City's rescission of the TUP and/or cancellation of the TUP event as described herein.
