2. SENIOR COMMUNITY EVENTS UPDATE

Chairperson Viayra reported on activities at Breezewood Village, including a Thanksgiving luncheon. She said the La Mirada Veterans Coordinating Council would present medallions to veterans residing at Breezewood Village on November 8.

Member Roman reported on activities at La Mirada Landmark.

Member Hall reported on activities at Lake Park La Mirada, including a Thanksgiving Luncheon and a Veterans Appreciation Day. She said she attended a recent Veterans Discussion Group meeting and met Senator Bob Archuleta.

Member Thomas reported on activities at Somerset Glen, including a Thanksgiving potluck and a monthly birthday celebration.

Member McCollum reported minimal activities were being offered at Vista Alicante. He said flyers advertising the City's events are provided to management but are not posted or distributed to residents.

Member Rosholt provided a reminder regarding daylight savings time. He provided positive feedback regarding the Community Health Information and Safety Fair, and the Fall Festival.

Vice Chairperson Torres thanked Members for their assistance with the La Mirada Veterans Coordinating Council's new program to honor local veterans.

NEW BUSINESS

3. 2022 SALUTETO VETERANS EVENT AND VETERANS DAY CEREMONY

Community Services Supervisor Lisa Montoya reported on the Salute to Veterans event on November 7 at the La Mirada Theatre for the Performing Arts and the Veterans Day Ceremony on November 11 in the Civic Center Plaza. She said the newly formed La Mirada Veterans Coordinating Council played a key role in recruiting event participants and developing new components for both events. She said La Mirada Transit would offer its services during the Veterans Day Ceremony from 9:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

Members commended Vice Chairperson Torres and the La Mirada Veterans Coordinating Council for their efforts in honoring veterans in the community.

Vice Chairperson Torres discussed the importance of honoring veterans who are unable to attend the City's in-person events by presenting the medallions at their respective residences. He said over 60 medallions would be presented by the La Mirada Veterans Coordinating Council this year.

Member Rosholt commented on the Salute to Veterans flyer which included the United States Space Force. He reported on the flag run from the UFC Gym to the Civic Center Plaza as part of the Veterans Day Ceremony.

4. 2022 HOLIDAY TOY AND FOOD DRIVE

Community Services Supervisor Montoya reported on the 2022 Holiday Toy and Food Drive beginning November 1 through December 9. She said the new unwrapped toys and non-perishable food items collected would be distributed to several local partner organizations.
