## **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

#### 2. SENIOR COMMUNITY SERVICES UPDATE

Chairperson Viayra reported on activities at Breezewood Village.

Vice Chairperson Hall reported on activities at Lake Park La Mirada.

Member Roman reported on activities at La Mirada Landmark. She said La Mirada Landmark will host a vintage car show on April 27.

Member Rosholt said the La Mirada Half Century Club inquired if the City of La Mirada can provide transportation for its senior trips to local casinos. He shared information regarding free resources for genealogy projects through the Family Search Center in Whittier.

Community Services Supervisor Lisa Montoya responded and thanked Member Rosholt for sharing the La Mirada Half Century Club's inquiry. She said the City is unable to provide transportation for the La Mirada Half Century Club.

Member Albert requested information regarding La Mirada Transit.

Community Services Supervisor Montoya responded and provided information regarding the City's transit services.

Member Torres reported on the La Mirada Veterans Coordinating Council. He said Rick Cline and Steve Jones were selected to serve as Chairperson and Vice Chairperson. Member Torres said the Council continues to explore new ways to increase its outreach and involvement in City events.

Member Rosholt commended the La Mirada Veterans Coordinating Council for its efforts in honoring local veterans.

## 3. OLDER AMERICANS RECOGNITION DAY AWARD

Community Services Supervisor Lisa Montoya provided a brief overview of the 2024 Older Americans Recognition Day (OARD) Awards Program. She said that after careful review of the program, it is recommended that past nominees be precluded from this year's award. Mrs. Montoya said four nominations for this year's award were received by the deadline of February 16. She recommended that Members discuss the four nominees and provide feedback to be shared with the Community Services Commission.

Members discussed Bruce Dixon, Donna Heckenlaible, Lana McMillen, and Chris Pflanzer's positive impact on the La Mirada community. Members said the nominees are all deserving of recognition. The Senior Council recommended that the Community Services Commission consider all four seniors to be selected as the honoree at the 2024 OARD awards ceremony.

Community Services Supervisor Montoya thanked the Senior Council for their positive feedback. She said the Senior Council's comments will be shared with the Community Services Commission.

Member Rosholt inquired if the City is able to increase the number of honorees for next year's OARD Awards Program.

Community Services Supervisor Montoya responded and said the OARD Awards Program is hosted by the County of Los Angeles. She said the County's guidelines limit the City to one honoree per year.

Member Rosholt recommended that Bruce Dixon, Donna Heckenlaible, Lana McMillen, and Chris Pflanzer be honored at the La Mirada Activity Center as part of Older Americans Month.

Community Services Supervisor Montoya said the four nominees will be invited to participate in various activities during Older Americans Month.
