#### 2. SENIOR COMMUNITY EVENTS UPDATE

Alternate Nelson reported a game night would take place at La Mirada Landmark on April 9 at 5:30 p.m.

Member Holtzen reported on community events at La Mirada Lake Park including fun and game nights on Mondays at 6:30 p.m., coffee and donuts on Saturdays at 8 a.m., and Bunco and Bingo on alternating Wednesdays at 7 p.m. She said a "Dinner out with Friends" would be held on April 26.

Member McCollum reported new policies were implemented by management and the list of monthly activities for Vista Alicante had not been released. Ms. Montoya responded and said that she would initiate communication with the new management.

Member Rosholt participated as a volunteer judge for the Spring Beautification program and said the program encouraged residents to take pride in their home. He attended the La Mirada City Council meeting on March 22 where Steve De Ruse was selected to serve as Mayor and Ed Eng as Mayor Pro Tem during the City Council reorganization. He reported on the "Captain K-9" Dog Walker Watch program and said it would teach residents to observe and report suspicious activity while they are walking their dogs. Vice Chairperson Torres participated as a volunteer judge for the Spring Beautification program. He reported SeniorNet's registration would take place on March 25 at 9:30 a.m. at the Activity Center. Member Hampton reported the Friends of the La Mirada Theatre attended a taping of "America's Got Talent" on March 22 and that rehearsals for "Dreamgirls" would take place on March 24 at the La Mirada Theatre for the Performing Arts. She said the La Mirada Symphony would present a free concert at the La Mirada Theatre for the Performing Arts on April 24.
